## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That RIDDLE RANCH, INC.

c/o Dorman Otley  
of Star Rt. 1, Box 121, Burns, State of Oregon, 97720, has made  
proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of  
Chapman Slough, tributary of Chapman Slough and McGee Slough

a tributary of Silvies River for the purpose of  
irrigation of 229.5 acres

under Permit No. 28812 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in  
accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from  
April 15, 1963

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes  
aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed  
2.85 cubic feet per second, being 1.00 c.f.s. from McGee Slough, 0.63 c.f.s.  
from Chapman Slough, and 0.61 c.f.s. from each of the two tributaries to Chapman  
Slough

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream.  
The point of diversion is located in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$  NE $\frac{1}{4}$ , SE $\frac{1}{4}$  NE $\frac{1}{4}$ , NE $\frac{1}{4}$  NW $\frac{1}{4}$ , SW $\frac{1}{4}$  NE $\frac{1}{4}$ , SW $\frac{1}{4}$  SW $\frac{1}{4}$ ,  
Section 9, T. 24 S., R. 31 E., W. M., #1-4330 feet North and 3450 feet East,  
#2-3700 feet North and 4210 feet East, #3-5270 feet North and 1600 feet East,  
#4-3970 feet North and 1680 feet East, #5-3260 feet North and 3460 feet East,  
#6-80 feet North and 1240 feet East, all from the SW Corner, Section 9

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other  
right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eighth of one cubic foot per second  
per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited  
to a diversion of not to exceed  $2\frac{1}{2}$  acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated  
during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall  
conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right  
is appurtenant, is as follows:

24.3 acres SW $\frac{1}{4}$  NW $\frac{1}{4}$   
25.0 acres SE $\frac{1}{4}$  NW $\frac{1}{4}$   
38.0 acres NE $\frac{1}{4}$  SW $\frac{1}{4}$   
26.6 acres NW $\frac{1}{4}$  SW $\frac{1}{4}$   
18.4 acres NE $\frac{1}{4}$  SW $\frac{1}{4}$   
31.0 acres SE $\frac{1}{4}$  SW $\frac{1}{4}$   
40.0 acres NW $\frac{1}{4}$  SE $\frac{1}{4}$   
26.2 acres SW $\frac{1}{4}$  SE $\frac{1}{4}$
