CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That

EDWARD L. CATE

of 525 Almer Rd. #309, Burlingame, State of California, 94010, has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of two wells

a tributary of Griffin Creek for the purpose of irrigation of 1.3 acres and temperature control of 1.3 acres

under Permit No. G-5193 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from May 20, 1971

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.14 cubic foot per second, being 0.013 c.f.s. for irrigation and 0.09 c.f.s. for temperature control from Well No. 1 and 0.007 c.f.s. for irrigation and 0.05 c.f.s. for temperature control from Well No. 2

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$, as projected within Overbeck DLC 71, Section 27, T. 37 S., R. 2 W., W. M., No. 1-230 feet North and 20 feet East; No. 2-220 feet North and 100 feet East, both from the SW Corner, Overbeck DLC 71.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year; and shall be further limited to appropriation of water only to the extent that it does not impair or substantially interfere with existing surface water rights of others;

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described, and is subject to the existing minimum flow policies established by the Water Policy Review Board.
