CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That

of 310 Ridgewood Dr., Jacksonville , State of Oregon, 97530 , has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of Applegate River

a tributary of Rogue River irrigation of 33.3 acres and supplemental irrigation of 32.7 acres

under Permit No. 33703 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from June 25, 1968

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.83 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SW4 NW4, as projected within La Clair DLC 38, Section 28, T. 38 S., R. 3 W., W. M., 380 feet North and 510 feet West from the Interior "L" Corner, La Clair DLC 38

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightiethof one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 44 acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described, and is subject to the existing minimum flow policies established by the Water Policy Review Board.
