a tributary of Rogue River supplemental irrigation of 32.5 acres

under Permit No. 34121 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from January 24, 1969

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 8.1 acre feet stored water only

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SW4 NE4, Section 8, T. 37 S., R. 1 W., W. M., 2330 feet South and 90 feet East from the Nk Corner, Section 8

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ------of one cubic foot per-secondper-acre, a diversion of 4% acre feet for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer. A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

> 0.7 acre NW: NEX 31.8 acres SW NEW Section 8 T. 37 S., R. 1 W., W. M.
