## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That

WILTON A. WHITE

of 3660 Kirtland Rd., Central Point, State of Oregon, 97501, has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of Bear Creek & Kelly Slough

a tributary of Rogue River for the purpose of temperature control of 40.1 acres

under Permit No. 35778 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from December 7, 1970

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 2.90 cubic feet per second, being 1.45 c.f.s. from Bear Creek and 1.45 c.f.s. from Kelly Slough

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$  NE $\frac{1}{4}$ , as projected within Hall DLC 50, Section 20, T. 36 S., R. 2 W., W. M., SE $\frac{1}{4}$  SE $\frac{1}{4}$ , Section 17, T. 36 S., R. 2 W., W. M., Creek-460 feet South and 140 feet East; Slough-1790 feet North and 740 feet East both from the NW Corner, Hall DLC 50

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to \_\_\_\_\_ of one cubic foot per second per acre,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.
