of Baker , State of Oregon has a right to the use of the waters of Powder River, tributary of Snake River for the purpose of the irrigation of 246 acres of land and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the STATE WATER BOARD of the State of Oregon, in Volume 6 , at page 291 ; that the priority of the right thereby confirmed dates from June 28, 1902 that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 1/40 of one cubic foot per second per acre; and shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree. A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water is appurtenant (or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use), is as follows: 26 acres in the Northeast quarter of Northeast quarter of Section Mine: 40 acres in the Northeast quarter of Southwest quarter; 40 acres in the Southeast quarter of Southwest quarter and 40 acres in the Southwest quarter of Southeast quarter of Section Ten: 40 acres in the Northeast quarter of Northwest quarter; 10 acres in the Northwest quarter of Northeast quarter; 10 acres in the Scuthwest quarter of Northeast quarter and 40 acres in the Southeast quarter of Northwest quarter of Section Fifteen, Township Eight South, Range Forty East of Willamette Meridian, in Baker County, Oregon. The right to the use of the water for irrigation purposes is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
