## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That

BILLY J. TOWERY

of Route 1, Box 389, Madras , State of Oregon 97741 , has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of Dry Canyon Creek

a tributary of Willow Creek irrigation of 78.6 acres

for the purpose of

under Permit No. 32742 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from February 19, 1968

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 1.31 cubic feet per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SE4 NE4, Section 8, T. 11 S., R. 13 E., W.M., 990 feet North and 320 feet West from the E4 Corner, Section 8.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-sixtieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2 acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, provided further that this right is limited to the amount of water available at the South line of the NW. Section 9, Township 11 South, Range 13 East, W.M., and shall not carry with it the right to compel the continuance of any waste water from lands irrigated above, or restrict North Unit Irrigation District in any way from recovering and reusing waste water from District lands, and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

29.0 acres SW4 NE4, 17.8 acres NE4; SE4; 10.1 acres NW4; SE4; 21.7 acres SE4; SE4; Section 7 T. 11 S., R. 13 E., W.M.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described. and is subject to the existing minimum flow policies established by the Water Policy Review Board.
