CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That FRED MCCLINTICK

of 2131 White School Rd., Cave Junction, State of Oregon, 97523, has
a right to the use of the waters of
Sucker Creek

a tributary of East Fork Illinois River for the purpose of
the irrigation of 41.4 acres

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for
Josephine County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of
the WATER RESOURCES DIRECTOR, in Volume 1, at page 253; that the priority of the
right thereby confirmed dates from 1858

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an
amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.822 cubic foot per
second, and that the use of water for irrigation purposes shall be confined to
the season April 1st to October 31st of each year,

The point of diversion is located in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 29, T. 39 S., R. 7 W., W. M.,
1600 feet North and 1650 feet West from the SE Corner, Section 29

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as
follows:

1.8 acres NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$
1.4 acres SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$
6.3 acres NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$
17.5 acres NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$
9.5 acres SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$
4.9 acres SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$

and said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained
in said decree.

This certificate is issued to correct and supersede certificate 44387 so as to
correctly show the amount of water to which such right is entitled.

And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.
The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of
use herein described.
