CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That FREDERIC & ROBERTA SCHILDMEYER

of Rt. 3, Box 1306, Klamath Falls , State of Oregon, 97601 , has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of a spring & unnamed stream

a tributary of Upper Klamath Lake for the purpose of irrigation of 440.0 acres

under Permit No. 35928 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from December 2, 1971

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 11.00 cubic feet per second, being 1.75 c.f.s. from the spring and 9.25 c.f.s. from the unnamed stream

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the All within Lot 5 (SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$), Section 6, T. 37 S., R. 9 E., W. M., #1-2800 feet North and 1130 feet East, #2-2640 feet North and 1140 feet East, #3-2640 feet North and 640 feet East, #4-2640 feet North and 600 feet East, all from the SW Corner, Section 6

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-fortieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3 acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:
