that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 166.0 acre feet stored water only

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NEW NEW, Section 21, T. 9 S., R. 1 W., W. M., 4180 feet North and 100 feet West from the SE Corner, Section 21; (Reservoir: NWz, Section 7, T. 10 S., R. 5 E., W. M.)

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ----- of one cubic foot per second per acre, a diversion of 24 acre feet for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, and is subject to the terms of contract No. 14-06-100-2819 between the Bureau of Reclamation and the applicant, a copy of which is on file in the records of the Water Resources Department.
