CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That

C. C. HEPLER

of Rt. 1, Hubbard , State of Oregon, 97032 , has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of unnamed stream and reservoir constructed under Application No. R-19438, Permit No. R-769

a tributary of Pudding River irrigation of 0.5 acre and operation of ram

for the purpose of

under Permit No. 15037 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from August 1, 1941

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.21 cubic foot per second, being 0.01 c.f.s. for irrigation and 0.2 c.f.s. for operation of ram

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SE's NE's, as projected within Jarius Bonney DLC 53, Section 35, T. 4 S., R. 1 W., W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed $2\frac{1}{2}$ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

This certificate describes that portion of the water right confirmed by prior certificate 14714, NOT modified by the provisions of an order entered on August 11, 1977, approving transfer application No. S-209. The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in reference to ORS 540.610.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described, and is subject to the existing minimum flow policies established by the Water Policy Review Board.
