 the WATER RESOURCES DIRECTOR, in Volume 10, at page 48; that the priority of the
 right thereby confirmed dates from 1886;

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an
 amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 1/60th of a second
 foot per acre or a total of 3 acre feet per acre during each irrigation season
 from March 1st to October 1st, and outside of the irrigation season not to exceed
 1/10th of a cubic foot per second for domestic and stock use.

 420 feet North and 450 feet West; 550 feet North and 270 feet West, both from the
