## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

**This Is to Certify, That** ERNEST BEHRMAN

of Rt. 1, Box 39, Banks, State of Oregon, 97106, has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of Bledsoe Creek & 21.0 acre feet from reservoir on Bausch Creek constructed under Application No. R-46130, Permit No. R-5492 a tributary of East Fork Dairy Creek for the purpose of irrigation of 107.3 acres

under Permit No. 34502 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from October 30, 1969

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 1.26 cubic feet per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$  NE $\frac{1}{4}$ , as projected within Northrop DLC 76, Section 4, T. 1 N., R. 3 W., W. M.; SW $\frac{1}{4}$  SE $\frac{1}{4}$ , as projected within Northrop DLC 44, Section 33, T. 2 N., R. 3 W., W. M., Bledsoe Creek-180 feet North and 2520 feet East; Bausch Creek Dam-760 feet North and 2360 feet East, both from the SW Corner Northrop DLC 76

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per acre per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated from direct flow and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2 $\frac{1}{2}$  acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year from direct flow and storage from reservoir constructed under Permit No. R-5492

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:
