CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

(For Rights which have been confirmed by the Courts)

This is to Certify, That F. W. McCAFFERY, RACHAEL McCAFFERY and JOHN W. DENNIS of Sisters State of Oregon has a right to the use of the waters of SQUAW CREEK, a tributary of Deschutes River

for the purpose of irrigation

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Crook County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the State Water Board Board of Control of the State of Oregon, in Volume 1, at page 453 ; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from 1885,

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed for the purpose aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purpose , and shall not exceed 2.4 cubic feet per second of time.

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water hereby confirmed is appurtenant, or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use, is as follows:

120 acres in the Southwest quarter (SW 1/4) of Section Four (4) in Township Fifteen (15) South of Range Ten (10) East of the Willamette Meridian, in Crook County, Oregon.

The right to the use of the water aforesaid hereby confirmed is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
