that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.59 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NEX NWA, as projected within Monroe DLC 44, Section 16, T. 1 N., R. 3 W., W. M., 1040 feet South and 540 feet East from the SW Corner, Cornelius DLC 42

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-cightlethof one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated from direct flow and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 21/2 acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year from direct flow and storage from reservoir constructed under Permit No. R-5797

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.
