CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

of Myrtle Creek , State of Oregon, 97457 , has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of North Myrtle Creek

a tributary of South Fork of Umpqua River the irrigation of 33.6 acres

for the purpose of

under Permit No. 879 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from September 25. 1911

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.42 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 4, T. 29 S., R. 4 W., W. M., 1100 feet South and 290 feet West from the N $\frac{1}{4}$ Corner, Section 4

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited toone-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or it equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed $2\frac{1}{2}$ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.
