## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

**This Is to Certify, That** LEAVITT LIVESTOCK CO.

of Rt. 8, Box 5, Lakeview, State of Oregon, 97630, has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of three unnamed drainage channels

a tributary of Thomas Creek for the purpose of irrigation of 159.5 acres

under Permit No. 33272 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from February 15, 1968 that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 3.99 cubic feet per second, being 0.42 c.f.s. from drainage channel No. 2, 1.24 c.f.s. from drainage channel No. 3 and 2.33 c.f.s. from drainage channel No. 4

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$  NW $\frac{1}{4}$ , Section 15, SE $\frac{1}{4}$  NE $\frac{1}{4}$ , Section 16, SW $\frac{1}{4}$  NW $\frac{1}{4}$ , Section 23, T. 37 S., R. 18 E., W. M., No. 2-9150 feet North and 180 feet East, No. 3-8140 feet North and 1840 feet West, No. 4-3220 feet North and 4110 feet East, all from the SW Corner, SE $\frac{1}{4}$ , SW $\frac{1}{4}$ , Section 22

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-fortieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2 $\frac{1}{2}$  acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:
