under Permit No. 32609 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from May 17. 1967

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.28 cubic foot per second, being 0.13 c.f.s. from unnamed stream and 0.15 c.f.s. from Pole Creek

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NW% SW%, SE% SW%, Section 22, T. 39 S., R. 41 E., W. M., unnamed stream: 2730 feet South and 830 feet East from the NW Corner, Section 22; Pole Creek: westerly diversion-1310 feet South and 1870 feet West, easterly diversion-1000 feet South and 1430 feet West, both from the NE Corner, SW% SE%, Section 22

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other ight existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightiethof one cubic foot per second er acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3 acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.
