of Rt. 1, Box 1150-A, Roseburg , State of Oregon, 97470 , has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of Elk Creek

a tributary of Umpqua River

for the purpose of

irrigation and supplemental irrigation of 85.6 acres

and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in under Permit No. 30066 accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from

September 25, 1964 for 0.44 c.f.s., October 26, 1964 for 0.26 c.f.s. that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.7 cubic foot per second, being 0.26 c.f.s. for primary irrigation and 0.44 c.f.s. for supplemental irrigation

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SE4 NW4, as projected within Lyons DLC 43, Section 22, T. 22 S., R. 5 W., W. M., 580 feet North and 420 feet East from the southerly SW Corner, Lyons DLC 43

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 23 acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:
