CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That **FRANK H. JACOBSEN**

of 1432 H.W. Keasey Rd., Roseburg , State of Oregon, 97470 , has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of Newton Creek

a tributary of South Umpqua River for the purpose of the irrigation of 1.9 acres

under Permit No. 26392 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from October 12, 1959 that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.023 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$, as projected within Lehnhart DLC 52, Section 14, T. 27 S., R. 6 W., W. M., South 9 degrees 20 minutes West, 1,455 feet from the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ Corner, Section 14

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, provided further that the right to the use of water is limited to a period when the flow in the South Umpqua River is 60 c.f.s. or more at its mouth,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

1.1 acres NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$
0.8 acre SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$
Both as projected within Lehnhart DLC 52
Section 14
T. 27 S., R. 6 W., W. M.

This certificate describes that portion of the water right confirmed by prior certificate 28836, NOT modified by the provisions of orders entered on January 14, 1977, approving transfer application No. 3502 and canceling a portion of the right described by the said prior certificate. The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in reference to ORS 540.610.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described. and is subject to the existing minimum flow policies established by the Water Policy Review Board.
