CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That

B. E. HOLLAND, SUCCESSOR IN INTEREST TO
R. W. ROWLEYof P. O. Box 64, Williams, State of Oregon, 97544, has
a right to the use of the waters of Williams Creeka tributary of Applegate River for the purpose of
stock and irrigation of 8.2 acresand that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for
Jackson County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of
the WATER RESOURCES DIRECTOR, in Volume 16, at page 523; that the priority of the
right thereby confirmed dates from January 14, 1904that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an
amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.16 cubic foot per
second.The point of diversion is located in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 35, T. 38 S., R. 5 W., W. M.A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as
follows:8.2 acres S $\frac{1}{2}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$
Section 35
T. 38 S., R. 5 W., W. M.This certificate describes that portion of the water right confirmed by prior
certificate 32944, NOT modified by the provisions of an order entered on
October 10, 1977, approving transfer application No. 3623.The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of
the water right in reference to ORS 540.610.And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.
The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of
use herein described.
