CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That ERNEST J. WALSH, M.D.

of 1112 Richmon Knoll, Fullerton, State of California 92631, has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of Louse Creek

a tributary of Jump-Off-Joe Creek for the purpose of irrigation of 12.3 acres

under Permit No. 4512 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from March 26, 1920 that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.155 cubic foot per second or its equivalent in case of rotation

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 30, T. 35 S., R. 5 W., W. M., 820 feet South and 610 feet West from the NE Corner of the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 30

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

12.3 acres SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$
Section 30
T. 35 S., R. 5 W., W. M.

This certificate describes that portion of the water right confirmed by prior certificate 37383, NOT modified by the provisions of an order entered on November 3, 1977, approving transfer application No. 3693.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in reference to ORS 540.610.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described. and is subject to the existing minimum flow policies established by the Water Policy Review Board.
