CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That TONY AMSTAD

of Rt. 4, Box 290, Sherwood, State of Oregon, 97140, has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of Tualatin River

a tributary of Willamette River for the purpose of irrigation of 91.4 acres

under Permit No. 35379 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from June 8, 1971 that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 1.14 cubic feet per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 12, NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 13, T. 2 S., R. 2 W., W. M., 1470 feet North; 410 feet South and 3060 feet West, both from the NE Corner, Section 13

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

6.0 acres SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$
21.0 acres SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$

16.8 acres NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$
36.4 acres NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$
11.2 acres NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$

T. 2 S., R. 2 W., W. M.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described. and is subject to the existing minimum flow policies established by the Water Policy Review Board.
