and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in under Permit No. 26028 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from

March 4, 1959 that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.607 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NW% SE%, as projected within Burford DLC 44, Section 24, T. 5 S., R. 7 W., W. M., 1725 feet North and 1575 feet West from the SE Corner, Section 24

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2½ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows: 5.2 acres SW4 NE%

12.7 acres SE4 NW4

22.9 acres NE% SW%

26.0 acres NW% SE%
