## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of

for the purpose of

under Permit No. 31508 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from

April 22, 1966 that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.33 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NW4 NW4, SW4 NW4, both as projected within Winkle DLC 48, Section 26, T. 13 S., R. 5 W., W. M., 1260 feet North and 1760 feet East; 820 feet North and 1760 feet East; 130 feet North and 1530 feet East, all from the SW Corner, Winkle DLC 48

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightiethof one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2½ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

10.8 acres NW4 NW4 3.0 acres SW4 NW4 8.5 acres NE¼ NE¼ 4.4 acres SE¼ NE¼

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the right in reference to ORS 540.610.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described. and is subject to the existing minimum flow policies established by the Water Policy Review Board.
