CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That WILLIAM WALTER WANKER & PAULINE D. WANKER

of Rt. 1, Box 517, West Linn, State of Oregon, 97068, has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of an unnamed spring

a tributary of Tualatin River for the purpose of domestic use for two families including the irrigation of lawn and garden not to exceed $\frac{1}{2}$ acre in area under Permit No. 36561 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from June 6, 1972

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.02 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$, as projected within Athey DLC 59, Section 28, T. 2 S., R. 1 E., W. M., 510 feet South and 30 feet West from the SW Corner, Wilson DLC 72

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to _____ of one cubic foot per second per acre,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

As projected within Athey DLC 59
Section 28
T. 2 S., R. 1 E., W. M.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described, and is subject to the existing minimum flow policies established by the Water Policy Review Board.
