## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That E. C. WYMAN

of 30 N. La Salle St., Chicago, State of Illinois, 60607, has  
a right to the use of the waters of Squaw Creek, (Decree says Pole Creek via Smith &  
Wilt Ditch)

a tributary of Deschutes River for the purpose of  
the irrigation of 63 acres

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for  
Deschutes County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of  
the WATER RESOURCES DIRECTOR, in Volume 1, at page 471; that the priority of the  
right thereby confirmed dates from 1885

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an  
amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 1.26 cubic feet per  
second, or its equivalent in case of rotation. The use hereunder shall conform  
to any reasonable rotation system ordered by the proper State Officer.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as  
follows:

3.0 acres NE $\frac{1}{4}$  SW $\frac{1}{4}$   
32.5 acres NW $\frac{1}{4}$  SW $\frac{1}{4}$   
22.5 acres SW $\frac{1}{4}$  SW $\frac{1}{4}$   
5.0 acres SE $\frac{1}{4}$  SW $\frac{1}{4}$

This certificate describes that portion of the water right confirmed by the prior  
certificate recorded at page 864, Volume 2, State Record of Water Right  
Certificates, NOT modified by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources  
Director entered on October 28, 1977, approving transfer application No. 3733.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the  
water right in reference to ORS 540.610.

And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.  
The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of  
use herein described.
