CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That M. H. & JULIA M. PINGLE

c/o Bruce E. Pingle
of P. O. Box 7, Butte Falls, State of Oregon, 97522, has made
proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of
Geppert Creek

a tributary of South Fork Rogue River for the purpose of
the irrigation of 54.2 acres and stock

under Permit No. 23728 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in
accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from
September 12, 1955
that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes
aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed
0.682 cubic foot per second, being 0.677 c.f.s. for irrigation and 0.005 c.f.s.
for stock

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream.
The point of diversion is located in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 26, T. 33 S., R. 3 E., W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other
right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second
per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited
to a diversion of not to exceed 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated
during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall
conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right
is appurtenant, is as follows:

Stock and 19.6 acres NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$
34.6 acres SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$
Section 26
T. 33 S., R. 3 E., W. M.

This certificate describes that portion of the water right confirmed by the prior
certificate recorded at page 31969, Volume 24, State Record of Water Right
Certificates, NOT canceled by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources
Director entered December 13, 1976.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the
water right in reference to ORS 540.610.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place
of use herein described. and is subject to the existing minimum flow policies
established by the Water Policy Review Board.
