a tributary of Little Butte Creek the irrigation of 24.0 acres

for the purpose of

under Permit No. 10768 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from November 12, 1932

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.30 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NW4 SE4, Section 15, T. 37 S., R. 1 E., W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightiethof one cubic foot per second per acre, during the irrigation season from April 1 to November 1 of each year

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as foll. is:

This certificate describes that portion of the water right confirmed by the prior

certificate recorded at page 10765, Volume 10, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT modified by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered on January 8, 1973, approving transfer application No. 2664. The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in reference to ORS 540.610.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described, and is subject to the existing minimum flow policies established by the Water Policy Review Board.
