CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That CHARLES T. AND MARY E. SWEENEY

of Medford, State of Oregon, 97526, has
a right to the use of the waters of Applegate River

a tributary of Rogue River for the purpose of
the irrigation of 12.9 acres

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Jackson County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the WATER RESOURCES DIRECTOR, in Volume 16, at page 523; that the priority of the right thereby confirmed dates from February 1892

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.26 cubic foot per second

The point of diversion is located in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 1, T. 38 S., R. 5 W., W. M., Laurel Hill Ditch-125 feet North and 500 feet East from the Center of Section 1

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

12.4 acres SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$
0.5 acre SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$
Section 21
T. 37 S., R. 5 W., W. M.

This certificate describes that portion of the water right confirmed by the prior certificate recorded at page 32850, Volume 24, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT modified by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered on August 18, 1977, approving transfer application No. 3436.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in reference to ORS 540.610.

And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree. The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
