CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This is to Certify, That THOS. H. TIBBS

of Sumpter, State of Oregon has a right to the use of
the waters of Deer Creek, tributary of Powder River and Powder River, tributary
of Snake River
for the purpose of the irrigation of 191 acres of land

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for
Baker County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order
Record of the STATE WATER BOARD of the State of Oregon, in Volume 6, at page 291;
that the priority of the right thereby confirmed dates from March 16, 1888 for Tract No. 1
and 1888 for Tract No. 2

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an
amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed $1/40$ of one cubic foot
per second per acre; and shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations
contained in said decree

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water is appurtenant
(or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use), is as follows:

Tract No. 1 from Deer Creek: 34 acres in the Southwest quarter of Northeast
quarter; 7 acres in the Southeast quarter of Northeast quarter; 15 acres in the
Northeast quarter of Northwest quarter; 40 acres in the Southeast quarter of
Northwest quarter and 15 acres in the Northeast quarter of Southwest quarter of
Section Eighteen, Township Ten South, Range Thirty-eight East of Willamette
Meridian, in Baker County, Oregon.

Tract No. 2 from Powder River: 30 acres in the Northeast quarter of North-
west quarter of Section Nineteen: 10 acres in the Northeast quarter of Southwest
quarter and 40 acres in the Southeast quarter of Southwest quarter of Section
Eighteen, Township Ten South, Range Thirty-eight East of Willamette Meridian,
in Baker County, Oregon.

The right to the use of the water for irrigation purposes is restricted to the lands or place
of use herein described.
