## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

**This Is to Certify, That** STAYTON CANNING COMPANY, COOPERATIVE

of 930 West Washington St., Stayton, State of Oregon, 97383, has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of North Santiam River and reservoir constructed under Application No. R-52838, Permit No. R-6170, and Detroit Reservoir constructed under Permit No. R-1625 a tributary of Santiam River for the purpose of irrigation and supplemental irrigation of 213.5 acres

under Permit No. 38205 and that said right to the use of said wa. has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from January 31, 1975

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 2.7 cubic feet per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the Lot 2 (NW $\frac{1}{4}$  SE $\frac{1}{4}$ ), Section 16, T. 9 S., R. 1 W., W. M., stream - 190 feet South and 500 feet East; reservoir - 120 feet South and 420 feet East, both from the Center, Section 16; Detroit Reservoir: NW $\frac{1}{4}$ , Section 7, T. 10 S., R. 5 E., W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated from direct flow and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2 $\frac{1}{2}$  acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year from direct flow and storage from unnamed reservoir constructed under Permit No. R-6170, and Detroit Reservoir constructed under Permit No. R-1625, and is subject to the terms and conditions of contracts No. 14-06-100-8541 and No. 14-06-100-8531 between the Bureau of Reclamation and the applicant, copies of which are in the records of the Water Resources Department. and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:
