CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That MARY LU DAVIS JOHNSON

of Rt. 3, Box 245, Walla Walla, State of Washington, 99362, has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of North Fork Cottonwood Creek

a tributary of Walla Walla River for the purpose of irrigation of 0.48 acre

under Permit No. 37615 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from February 9, 1973 that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.01 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 18, T. 6 N., R. 37 E., W. M., 1516 feet North and 2046 feet East from the SW Corner, Section 18

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ~~of one cubic foot per second per acre~~ 0.0375 of one cubic foot per second or its equivalent for each acre irrigated.

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

0.48 acre NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$
Section 18
T. 6 N., R. 37 E., W. M.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described. and is subject to the existing minimum flow policies established by the Water Policy Review Board.
