under Perinit No. 6-825 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from February 24, 1958

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.10 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SW4 NW4, as projected within Gleeson DLC 49, Section 5, T. 5 S., R. 1 N., W. M., 430 feet South and 1480 feet East from the NW re-entrant Corner DLC 49

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightiethof one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2½ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer. A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

8.9 acres SW NW

0.3 acre SE4 NW4 0.5 acre NW SW

All as projected within P. Gleeson DLC 49

T. 5 S., R. 1 W., W. M. This certificate describes that portion of the water right confirmed by the prior certificate recorded at page 28362, Volume 20, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT canceled by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered on June 23, 1977. The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in reference to ORS 540.610.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described. and is subject to the existing minimum flow policies established by the Water Policy Review Board.
