that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed three acre feet per acre in any irrigation season, diverted at a rate of not to exceed one-fortieth of a cubic foot per second

The point of diversion is located in the SEk SEk, Section 13, T. 45., R. 39 E., W. M., ~710 feet North and 400 feet West from the SE Corner, Section 13

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

10.0 acres S½ S½ SW¾ SW¾ Section 14 T. 4 S., R. 39 E., W. M.

This certificate describes that portion of the water right confirmed by the prior certificate 40632, Volume 32, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT modified by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered on April 20, 1977, approving transfer application No. 3439.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in reference to ORS 540.610.

And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree. The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
