## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That

ROBERT W. BRAINARD

of Rt. 2, Box 76-C, Willamina , State of Oregon, 97396 , has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of Willamina River

a tributary of Yamhill River the irrigation of 3.4 acres

for the purpose of

under Permit No. 10231 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from May 28, 1931

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.04 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SW4 NE4, as projected within Burford DLC 44, Section 24, T. 5 S., R. 7 W., W. M., 2480 feet North and 710 feet West from the NE Corner, of Fendall DLC 39

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited toone-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2½ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right 2.5 acres SW4 NE4 0.9 acre SE4 NE4 is appurtenant, is as follows:

Both as projected within Burford DLC 44 Section 24

T. 5 S., R. 7 W., W. M. This certificate describes that portion of the water right confirmed by the prior certificate recorded at page 15372, Volume 13, State Record of Water Right Certificates, modified under the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered on April 10, 1973, approving transfer application No. 2690, excluding the portion thereof further modified by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered on December 21, 1976, approving transfer application No. 3500.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described. and is subject to the existing minimum flow policies established by the Water Policy Review Board.
