## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

**This Is to Certify, That** ROGER E. CAWOOD

of 8905 S.E. Powell Blvd., Portland, State of Oregon, 97266, has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of Clear Creek

a tributary of Clackamas River for the purpose of the irrigation of 4.0 acres

under Permit No. 20682 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from February 23, 1950 that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.05 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$  SW $\frac{1}{4}$ , as projected within R. Mattoon DLC 47, Section 10, T. 3 S., R. 3 E., W. M., 1370 feet North and 1600 feet East from the SW Corner, Section 10

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2 $\frac{1}{2}$  acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

2.9 acres NE $\frac{1}{4}$  SW $\frac{1}{4}$   
1.1 acres SE $\frac{1}{4}$  SW $\frac{1}{4}$   
Both as projected within R. Mattoon DLC 47  
Section 10  
T. 3 S., R. 3 E., W. M.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in place of use and point of diversion approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered on June 6, 1975 and together with certificate of water right recorded on page 43738, Volume 35, State Record of Water Right Certificates, supersedes certificate of water right recorded on page 34842, Volume 26, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described. and is subject to the existing minimum flow policies established by the Water Policy Review Board.
