CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That MARJORIE KVAMME

of Rt. 1, Box 566, Boring, State of Oregon, 97009, has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of two wells

a tributary of Johnson Creek for the purpose of domestic use for 100 space mobile home park including irrigation of lawn and garden not exceeding $\frac{1}{2}$ acre for each space, one house, and use in recreation hall. under Permit No. G-5247 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from June 11, 1973

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.2 cubic foot per second; with primary appropriation to be made up from East Well and West Well to be maintained as alternate source in event of failure of East Well system

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 34, NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 35, T. 1 S., R. 4 E., W. M.; West Well-South 24 degrees 04 minutes West 459.5 feet; East Well-South 78 degrees 24 minutes 30 seconds East 199.06 feet, both from the NW Corner, Section 35

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to----- of one cubic foot per second per acre,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described. and is subject to the existing minimum flow policies established by the Water Policy Review Board.
