that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.05 cubic foot per second; measured at the head of the ditch or the point where the same leaves the natural stream, from April 1st to October 1st of each year.

The point of diversion is located in the NE¼ SW¾, Section 4, T. 36 S., R. 1 E., W. M., 620 feet South and 1610 feet East from the W¼ Corner, Section 4

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

2.0 acres NE¼ SW¼ Section 4 T. 36 S., R. 1 E., W. M.

This certificate supersedes the certificate recorded at page 17183, Volume 14, State Record of Water Right Certificates, and confirms a change in point of diversion under the provisions of an order of the State Engineer entered on December 27, 1967, approving transfer application No. W-124.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in reference to ORS 540.610.

And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree. The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
