and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Josephine County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the WATER RESOURCES DIRECTOR, in Volume 1, at page 252; that the priority of the right thereby confirmed dates from 1893 for 31.94 acres; 1872 for 25 acres

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.65 cubic foot per second for 31.94 acres and 0.5 cubic foot per second for 25 acres; that the use of water for irrigation purposes shall be confined to the season April 1 to October 31 of each year.
