CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That

CITY OF ALBANY

of P. O. Box 490, Albany, State of Oregon, 97321, has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of South Santiam River and reservoir constructed under Application No. R-45202, Permit No. R-5151 a tributary of Willamette River for the purpose of recreation, fish culture, and beautification - Waverly and Timber-Linn Lakes

under Permit No. 33198 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from May 29, 1968 that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 2.0 cubic feet per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$, as projected within Cheadle DLC 55, Section 19, T. 12 S., R. 1 W., W. M., 1400 feet North and 1360 feet West from the NE Corner, Cheadle DLC 38, Section 19, T. 12 S., R. 1 W., W. M.; Lake Outlets: Waverly - 640 feet South and 1570 feet West from the NE Corner, Cox DLC 49, Section 4, Timber-Linn - 620 feet South and 2320 feet West from the *
The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to _____ of one cubic foot per second per acre,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.
A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:
