of Rt. 1, Box 2512, Sweet Home , State of Oregon, 97386 , has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of 4 springs, unnamed stream and Rickman's Pond constructed under Application No. R-48827, Permit No. R-5923 a tributary of South Santiam River for the purpose of domestic use for one family, fish culture, and irrigation of 4.1 acres under Permit No. 36596 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from November 8, 1971 that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.075 cubic foot per second, being 0.005 c.f.s. from 4 springs for domestic use, 0.02 c.f.s. from unnamed stream and reservoir for fish culture and 0.95 c.f.s. from unnamed stream for irrigation or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SE4 NE4, NE4 SE4, Section 14, T. 13 S., R. 1 W., W. M., Spring No. 1-1270 feet North and 1070 feet East, No. 2-1190 feet North and 1070 feet East, No. 2-1190 feet North

W. M., Spring No. 1-1270 feet North and 1070 feet East, No. 2-1190 feet North and 1060 feet East, No. 3-1030 feet North and 840 feet East, No. 4-370 feet North and 480 feet East, Diversion Point-80 feet South and 880 feet East, Dam-200 feet South and 20 feet East, all from the NE Corner, NWA SEA, Section 14 The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2½ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

0.3 acre SE½ NE½ Fish Culture & 3.8 acres NE½ SE½ Domestic NW½ SE½ Section 14 T. 13 S., R. 1 W., W. M.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described. and is subject to the existing minimum flow policies established by the Water Policy Review Board.
