of Rt. 1, Box 179, Gervais , State of Oregon, 97026 , has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of an unnamed stream

a tributary of Pudding River the irrigation of 7.3 acres

for the purpose of

under Permit No.21264 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from March 25. 1952

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and he sty confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said surposes, and shall not exceed 0.09 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SW4 NE4, Section 31, T. 5 S., R. 1 W., W. M., 930 feet North and 1480 feet West, 530 feet North and 1480 feet West, both from the E $_{4}$ Corner, Section 31

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2½ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

7.3 acres SW4 NE4 Section 31 T. 5 S., R. 1 W., W. M.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in place of use approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered February 25, 1974 and supersedes certificate of water right recorded on page 22218, Volume 16, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes afresaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described. and is subject to the existing minimum flow policies established by the Water Policy Review Board.
