that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually benefi in the y used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.18 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SE½ SE½, as projected within J. Brown DLC 47, Section 27, T. 6 S., R. 1 W., W. M., 2920 feet South and 480 feet East from the NW Corner, J. Brown DLC 47

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited tone-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2½ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenent, is as follows:

1.6 acres SW\ SE\ 11.3 acres SE\ SE\ Both as projected within J. Brown DLC 47 Section 27 1.1 acres NE\ NE\ As projected within J. Brown DLC 47 Section 34 T. 6 S., R. 1 W., W. M.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the hards or place of use herein described and is subject to the existing minimum flow policies established by the Water Policy Review Board.
