a tributary of Tutuilla Creek irrigation of 70.7 acres

for the purpose of

under Permit No. 33931 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from February 7, 1969

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.34 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NE½ SW½, Section 18, T. 2 N., R. 33 E., W. M.; SW½ NE½; SE½ NW½, Section 13, T. 2 N., R. 32 E., W. M.; No. 1-950 feet South and 1100 feet East from the W½ Corner, Section 18, T. 2 N., R. 33 E., W. M.; No. 2-290 feet North and 1130 feet East, No. 3-60 feet North and 340 feet West, both from the C½ Corner, Section 13, T. 2 N., R. 32 E., W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-fortieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 4½ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.
