under Permit No. 21693 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from July 29. 1952

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 3.0 acre feet stored water only; being 1.5 a.f. from each reservoir

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SE4 NH4, as projected within Chiles DLC 44 and SE4 NE4, as projected within Wade DLC 47, Section 8, T. 3 S., R. 4 E., W. M.
