CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This is to Certify, That BLONDINA F. VonBOGGET, 492 Ash Street
of Portland, State of Oregon has a right to the use of
the waters of Ruckles Creek, tributary of Powder River
for the purpose of the irrigation of 118 acres of land

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for
Baker County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order
Record of the STATE WATER BOARD of the State of Oregon, in Volume 6, at page 291;
that the priority of the right thereby confirmed dates from 1894 for 56 acres and 1904
for 62 acres

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an
amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed $\frac{1}{40}$ of one cubic foot
per second per acre; and shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations
contained in said decree

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water is appurtenant
(or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use), is as follows:

10 acres in the Northwest quarter of Northeast quarter and 12 acres in the
Northeast quarter of Northeast quarter of Section Thirty-two; 27 acres in the
Southwest quarter of Northeast quarter; 36 acres in the Northwest quarter of
Southeast quarter and 33 acres in the Southwest quarter of Southeast quarter of
Section Twenty-nine, Township Eight South, Range Forty-two East of Willamette
Meridian, in Baker County, Oregon.

The right to the use of the water for irrigation purposes is restricted to the lands or place
of use herein described.
