of 300 State Highway Bldg., Salem , State of Oregon, 97310 , has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of Willamette River

a tributary of Columbia River irrigation of 36.0 acres

for the purpose of

under Permit No. 37827 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from December 27, 1974

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.45 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SW_4 NE $_4$, as projected within Fish DLC 45, Section 27, T. 3 S., R. 1 E., W. M., 1250 feet North and 230 feet East from the Center, Section 27

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foct per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed $2\frac{1}{2}$ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

21.6 acres SW4 NE4
As projected within Fish DLC 45
0.5 acre Lot 4 (NE4 NW4)
12.2 acres SE4 NW4
1.6 acres NE4 SW4
0.1 acre NW4 SE4
As projected within Fish DLC 45
Section 27
T. 3 S., R. 1 E., W. M.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described. and is subject to the existing minimum flow polices established by the Water Policy Review Board.
