CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That MARK ROY MAHONE

of 17975 Archwood St., Reseda, State of California, 91335, has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of Rogue River

a tributary of Pacific Ocean for the purpose of the irrigation of 6.0 acres

under Permit No. 11137 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from December 15, 1933 that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.075 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the Lot 1 (NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$), Section 21, T. 34 S., R. 1 W., W. M., 290 feet South and 1000 feet West from the NE corner of Section 21.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed $4\frac{1}{2}$ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

6.0 acres NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$
Section 21
T. 34 S., R. 1 W., W. M.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in point of diversion approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered August 2, 1972 and together with certificate of water right recorded on page 38780, Volume 30, State Record of Water Right Certificates, supersedes certificate of water right recorded on page 11117, Volume 10, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described, and is subject to the existing minimum flow policies established by the Water Policy Review Board.
