CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, ThatMELVIN M. TOOTHMAN, SUCCESSOR IN INTEREST
TO AMOS AND SUSIE SMITHof Williams, State of Oregon, 97544, has
a right to the use of the waters of West Fork Williams Creeka tributary of Williams Creek for the purpose of
irrigation of 3.5 acresand that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for
Jackson County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of
the WATER RESOURCES DIRECTOR, in Volume 16, at page 523; that the priority of the
right thereby confirmed dates from December, 1908that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an
amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.05 cubic foot
per secondThe point of diversion is located in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 35, T. 38 S., R. 5 W., W. M.A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as
follows:3.5 acres SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$
Section 34
T. 38 S., R. 5 W., W. M.This certificate describes that portion of the water right confirmed by the prior
certificate recorded at page 32952, Volume 25, State Record of Water Right
Certificates, NOT modified by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources
Director entered on December 8, 1977, approving transfer application No. 3731.The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the
water right in reference to ORS 540.610.And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.
The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of
use herein described.
